

# THE EDUCATION BOARDS EMPLOYMENT REGULATIONS 1958, AMENDMENT NO. 16

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 8th day of August 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Education Boards Employment Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 16, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Boards Employment Regulations 1958\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Morning and afternoon tea—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 18, the following regulation:
- "18A. (1) Subject to subclause (2) of this regulation, each Board shall provide sufficient tea, coffee, sugar, and milk to make a drink available for each whole-time officer and temporary employee during each morning and afternoon break provided for in regulation 16 (1) of these regulations.
- "(2) Where no such drink can be made available to a whole-time officer or temporary employee in accordance with subclause (1) of this regulation, the Board shall pay him an allowance at the same rate as that for the time being determined by the State Services Commission in respect of persons employed in the Public Service."

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations make provision for Education Board employees to be provided with free morning and afternoon tea.
