



**THE EDUCATION BOARDS' EMPLOYMENT
REGULATIONS 1958, AMENDMENT NO. 8**

At the Government House at Wellington this 11th day of August 1965

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Boards' Employment Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Boards' Employment Regulations 1958* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 19 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

“(1) Whole-time officers of a Board, on completing five years' service or on attaining Grade C or any higher Grade, shall be granted 15 working days' annual leave in the leave year in which they complete that service or attain that Grade and in each succeeding leave year.”
