THE HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Board Grants Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Where any Education Board grants or has granted to its officers salary increases in accordance with the scale prescribed by clause 2 (2) (b) of Principal Order No. 27 made by the Government Service Tribunal and dated the 17th day of November, 1950, there may be paid to the Board, by way of addition to the grant for general purposes referred to in paragraph (a) of regulation 2 of the principal regulations, such sum as the Minister of Education approves for the purpose of reimbursing the Board for such proportion of the amount of those salary increases as is properly chargeable to the Board's General Fund in respect of the period which commenced on the 1st day of April, 1950, and ends on the 31st day of January, 1951.
