THE HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Board Grants Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended, as from the 31st day of January 1953, by omitting from paragraph (d) the words "rate of £1", and substituting the words "rate of 15s."

3. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in paragraph (d) of regulation 2 of the principal regulations, the grant payable under that paragraph for the period commencing on the passing of these regulations and ending with the 31st day of January 1953 shall be at the rate necessary to reduce the average rate of the grant payable under that paragraph for the period commencing on the 1st day of April 1952 and ending with the 31st day of January 1953 to 15s. a year for each pupil to whom the paragraph applies.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations reduce the rate of the grant payable to Education Boards for pupils attending approved classes at manual training centres.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 18 December 1952.
