**THE EDUCATION BOARD GRANTS REGULATIONS 1952,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Board Grants Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended, as from the 31st day of March 1953, by omitting from paragraph (f) the words "rate of 1s. 2d.", and substituting the words "rate of 1s. 3d."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations provide that the rate of the maintenance grant payable to Education Boards out of moneys appropriated by Parliament is to be increased from 1s. 2d. to 1s. 3d. per square foot of the relevant buildings.
