At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of October 1955

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Board Grants Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations, as amended by regulation 2 of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 3, is hereby further amended as follows:

(a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the following words—	£
“For the first 10,000 pupils	135
“For all pupils in excess of 10,000	80”:
(b) By substituting the following words—	£
“For the first 10,000 pupils	140
“For all pupils in excess of 10,000	85”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
