**THE EDUCATION BOARD GRANTS REGULATIONS 1959,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

COBHAM, Governor-General

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 18th day of January 1961

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Board Grants Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1959\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subparagraph (i) of paragraph (a), and substituting the following subparagraph:

“(i) An amount determined in accordance with the following scale:

Number of Pupils on the Rolls of Public Schools in the District of the Education Board Ascertained in Accordance With These Regulations (Including Pupils on the Rolls of Intermediate Schools and Intermediate Departments Attached to District High Schools, and on the Rolls of Secondary Departments of District High Schools)	Amount for Each Complete 100 and the Balance (if Any) in Excess of Every Complete 100 of the Pupils
For the first 10,000 pupils .....	£ 155
For all pupils in excess of 10,000	106”

3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words "not less than 16s. 3d. and not more than £1 1s. 3d. for each such pupil", and substituting the words "not less than 17s. 2d. and not more than £1 3s. for each such pupil".

4. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (c), and substituting the following paragraph:

"(c) A grant at the rate of £3 5s. for each secondary pupil on the rolls of district high schools in the district of the Board, to be applied as follows:

"(i) £1 5s. of the grant for each secondary pupil shall be distributed by the Board to the School Committees of district high schools for the payment of incidental expenses:

"(ii) 10s. of the grant for each secondary pupil shall be expended for the provision of the services mentioned in subparagraph (i) of paragraph (b) of this regulation:

"(iii) The remainder of the grant shall be expended on the provision of books, materials, and equipment for the teaching of physical education, social studies, music, science, and other subjects to pupils in the secondary departments of district high schools, and for the provision of the services mentioned in subparagraphs (i) to (vi) of paragraph (b) of this regulation:".

5. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (g), and substituting the following paragraph:

"(g) A grant at the rate of £6 10s. for each student not enrolled under a post-primary teacher studentship who is on the roll of any teachers training college in the district of the Board on the 1st day of March in the year of the grant, of which grant £1 10s. shall be expended upon books for the library of the teachers training college, and the balance shall be expended upon the teaching of swimming, class materials and equipment, expenses of museum classes, physical education, and other incidental expenses, the cost of office expenses (excluding office salaries) at the teachers training college, and the medical examination of applicants for admission to the teachers training college:

"Provided that the Minister may approve of the rate of the grant being increased in respect of such students who are metalwork, woodwork, science, commercial, or homecraft students by such amount as he thinks fit, but so that the amount of the grant shall not exceed £18 for every such student who is a metalwork student or a woodwork student or £7 15s. for every such student who is a science student, a commercial student, or a homecraft student:".

6. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (k), and substituting the following paragraph:

"(k) A grant at the rate of £1 for each student enrolled under a post-primary teacher studentship who is on the roll of any teachers training college in the district of the Board on the 1st day of March in the year of the grant, of which grant 5s. shall be expended upon books for the library of the teachers training college for the use of those students:".

7. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the figures "4s. 3d.", and substituting the figures "5s. 2d."

8. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 3, the following regulation:

"3A. In addition to the grants payable under paragraphs (g), (k), and (l) of regulation 2 of these regulations, the Minister, having regard to the additional costs incurred by a Board in the provision of heating, power, and water at any teachers training college in its district by reason of the situation of or the type of the buildings in use at that teachers training college, may authorise payment, out of money appropriated by Parliament for the purpose, of a grant to the Board at a rate not exceeding £1 5s. for each student not enrolled under a post-primary teacher studentship who is on the roll of the teachers training college on the 1st day of March of the year of the grant."
