Pursuant to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Board Grants Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations, as amended by regulation 2 of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 2, is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words "not less than 17s. 8d. and not more than £1 3s. 6d. for each pupil", and substituting the words "not less than 17s. 11d. and not more than £1 3s. 9d. for each pupil".

(2) Regulation 2 of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1959,

Amendment No. 2, is hereby consequentially revoked.
