Pursuant to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Board Grants Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations, as amended by regulation 2 of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 6, is hereby further amended by revoking subparagraph (i) of paragraph (a), and substituting the following subparagraph:

"(i) An amount determined in accordance with the following scale:

Number of Pupils on the Rolls of Public Schools in the District of the Education Board Ascertained in Accordance With These Regulations (Including Pupils on the Rolls of Intermediate Schools and Intermediate Departments Attached to District High Schools, and on the Rolls of Secondary Departments of District High Schools)

Amount for Each Complete 100 and the Balance (if Any) in Excess of Every Complete 100 of the Pupils

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for an increase in the amount of the grant to Education Boards for general purposes; also for an increase in the amount of the grant to Education Boards for the maintenance and repair of schools and teachers' residences and for minor capital expenditure, etc.
