HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Education Board Grants Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1970* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Grants for general and special purposes—(1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (b) of subclause (1) the words "than \$2.78 and not more than \$4.53", and substituting the words "than \$2.90 and not more than \$4.77".

(2) The said regulation 2 is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (c) of subclause (1) the words "of \$20.15 per pupil for the first 100 secondary pupils and \$12.35 for", and substituting the words "of \$21.65 per pupil for the first 100 secondary pupils and \$13.25 for".

3. Additional grants for heating of school premises—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$2.32", and substituting the expression "\$2.52".
