ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 29th day of August 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

—

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education Board Grants Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Board Grants Regulations 1973* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Grant for incidental expenses—(1) Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (c), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(c) The purchase of textbooks within the meaning of the Free Textbooks in Schools Regulations 1975 and the cost of exchanging library books between schools:”.

(2) The said regulation 4 is hereby further amended by revoking subclause (f).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the principal regulations to allow grants to be spent on textbooks, but not on journeys for special purposes.
