ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 12th day of February, 1941.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act, 1934, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Export Butter-box Pool Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Export Butter-box Pool Regulations 1938* (hereinafter called the principal regulations) as amended by the Export Butter-box Pool Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 1† (hereinafter called Amendment No. 1).

3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking clause (5) thereof as inserted by regulation 4 of Amendment No. 1 and substituting the following clause :—

"(5) At any time during the season or after the close of the season the Board, in consultation with the Director of Forestry, may consider any evidence—

"(i) That the actual prices paid at the time of purchase by any licensee for timber to be used in the manufacture of export butter-boxes was higher or lower than the value of the timber estimated pursuant to paragraph (a) of clause (1) hereof; or

"(ii) That in the manufacture of export butter-boxes by any licensee overtime was reasonably and justifiably worked and that by reason of the rate of wages paid for overtime the actual cost of manufacture was higher than the manufacturing-allowance fixed pursuant to paragraph (b) of clause (1) aforesaid—

and may thereupon make such adjustment of the provisional price payable to that licensee as the Board deems just and equitable, and any such adjustment may, in the discretion of the Board, be retrospective so as to relate to boxes already delivered and paid for."
