THE EDUCATION BOARDS (TRAVELLING-EXPENSES) REGULATIONS 1944

At the Government House at Wellington, this 6th day of December, 1944

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Boards (Travelling-expenses) Regulations 1944, and shall come into force on the 6th day of December, 1944.
- 2. (1) These regulations apply with respect to the payment of travelling-expenses to members of Education Boards in accordance with section 31 of the Education Act, 1914.
- (2) All moneys paid by an Education Board pursuant to the said section and these regulations shall be paid out of the Board's General Fund.
- 3. The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941* shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations.
- 4. For the purposes of these regulations the rate of the subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 4 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941* shall be 22s. 6d. a day.
- 5. For the purposes of these regulations the rate of the mileageallowance referred to in Regulation 11 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941* for journeys undertaken in a motor-vehicle shall be 8d. a mile, and the actual garage expenses referred to in that regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for each night.
- 6. The regulations relating to the expenses of members of Education Boards made by Order in Council dated the 21st day of April, 1921, are hereby revoked.
