



THE EDUCATION BURSARIES REGULATIONS 1981

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 7th day of December 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education Bursaries Regulations 1981.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Bursaries to which these regulations apply—These regulations apply to all bursaries granted under any of the following regulations:

- (a) The School Boarding Bursaries Regulations 1972;
- (b) The Secondary School Academic Bursaries Regulations 1973;
- (c) The Secondary School Technical Bursaries Regulations 1977;
- (d) The Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1977.

3. Value of bursaries—Subject to the provisions of the regulations under which it was granted, the holder for the time being of a bursary to which these regulations apply shall be paid under that bursary at the rate of \$750 per year.

4. Value limited in respect of 1981—Notwithstanding regulation 3 of these regulations, no holder of a bursary to which these regulations apply shall in the year 1981 be paid amounts under that bursary that exceed \$716.67 in the aggregate.

5. Revocation—The Education Bursaries Regulations 1980 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the annual value of bursaries under the School Boarding Bursaries Regulations 1972, the Secondary School Academic Bursaries Regulations 1973, the Secondary School Technical Bursaries Regulations 1977, and the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1977 from \$700 to \$750. In 1981 the increase applies to the third term only.
