

## THE EDUCATION BURSARIES REGULATIONS 1984

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 16th day of July 1984

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education Bursaries Regulations 1984.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1985.
- **2. Bursaries to which regulations apply**—These regulations apply to all bursaries granted under any of the following regulations:
  - (a) The School Boarding Bursaries Regulations 1972:
  - (b) The Secondary School Technical Bursaries Regulations 1977:
  - (c) The Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1977.
- **3. Value of bursaries**—Subject to the provisions of the regulations under which it was granted, the holder for the time being of a bursary to which these regulations apply shall be paid under that bursary at the rate of \$1,060 per year.

**4. Revocation**—The Education Bursaries Regulations 1983\* are hereby consequentially revoked.

# **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase from 1 January 1985 the annual value of bursaries under the School Boarding Bursaries Regulations 1972, the Secondary School Technical Bursaries Regulations 1977, and the Secondary Schools Bursaries Regulations 1977, from \$980 to \$1,060.
