**THE EDUCATION (ASSESSMENT, CLASSIFICATION, AND APPOINTMENT) REGULATIONS 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 24th day of July 1962

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (Assessment, Classification, and Appointment) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Assessment, Classification, and Appointment) Regulations 1957\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 24, and substituting the following regulation:

“24. The review shall be made by two Inspectors nominated by the District Senior Inspector, one of whom shall, if possible, be the Inspector who originally inspected the teacher. Any change of general assessment recommended by the reviewing Inspectors shall be considered by the District Board of Inspectors who shall decide whether or not the assessment is to be altered.”

3. Regulation 43 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following subclause:

“(4) Notwithstanding anything in the foregoing provisions of this regulation, where applications have been invited for appointment to the position of the Principal of a secondary school or technical school which has been recognised by the Minister as a Forms I to VI secondary school or technical high school, primary teachers holding positions as Head Teachers of schools of Grade VI or a higher grade, or holding positions which in the opinion of the Director are equivalent thereto, may be considered for appointment to the position in addition to those teachers

classified by the Director in accordance with these regulations as post-primary teachers; and every such primary teacher who applies for the position shall be deemed to have been classified by the Director in accordance with these regulations as a post-primary teacher in Grade V for the purposes of the appointment.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations clarify regulation 24 of the principal regulations, which relates to the review of a teacher's general assessment; and extend regulation 43 of those regulations so as to provide for primary teachers holding positions as Head Teachers of schools of Grade VI or a higher grade, or holding positions which in the opinion of the Director are equivalent thereto, to be considered for appointment to the position of Principal of a Forms I to VI post-primary school.
