



THE EDUCATION (ASSESSMENT, CLASSIFICATION, AND APPOINTMENT) REGULATIONS 1965, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 19th day of December 1966

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (Assessment, Classification, and Appointment) Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Assessment, Classification and Appointment) Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (c) of subclause (1), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(c) He will, in the case of an application for a report in a higher division, complete the qualifying service for a report in that division not later than the 31st day of October of the year immediately following that in which he makes his application.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations change the date by which a primary teacher can complete the qualifying service for a personal report in a higher division.
