**THE EDUCATION (ASSESSMENT, CLASSIFICATION, AND APPOINTMENT) REGULATIONS 1976, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of October 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement—**(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education (Assessment, Classification, and Appointment) Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Assessment, Classification, and Appointment) Regulations 1976\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Date of Appointment of Principal of New Intermediate School—**The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 42, and substituting the following regulation:

“42. **Date of Appointment of Principal of certain new schools—**Where a Board, in accordance with the provisions of these regulations, appoints a Principal to a new school (being a primary school of grade VIA or higher or an intermediate school) that has not yet opened, the appointment may be made to take effect on a date before the opening date of the school, and the salary for that position shall be payable on and after that date, but in no case shall the appointment or the salary for the position commence on a date earlier than the 1st day of November of the preceding year if the school is to open on the first school day in February or on a date earlier than 6 weeks before the opening date of the school in any other case.”

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations extend the application of provisions that at present relate to principals appointed to new intermediate schools, to new primary schools of Grade VIA or higher.
