**THE EXCHANGE CONTROL EXEMPTION NOTICE 1965,
AMENDMENT NO. 11**

PURSUANT to the Exchange Control Regulations 1965*, the Minister of Finance hereby gives the following notice.

—

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Exchange Control Exemption Notice 1965, Amendment No. 11, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Exchange Control Exemption Notice 1965† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Sterling area—The Schedule to the principal notice (as substituted by the Exchange Control Exemption Notice 1965, Amendment No. 5‡) is hereby amended by inserting, under the reference to Australia, the word “Bangladesh”.
