



THE EXCHANGE CONTROL EXEMPTION NOTICE 1965, AMENDMENT NO. 2

—

PURSUANT to the Exchange Control Regulations 1965*, the Minister of Finance hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Exchange Control Exemption Notice 1965, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Exchange Control Exemption Notice 1965† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking clause 3, and substituting the following clause:

“3. (1) There is hereby exempted from the application of regulation 3 (a) of the regulations the taking by travellers of New Zealand money (being notes in denominations of 10s. or £1 or coin of any denomination) not exceeding £5, of which not more than £2 may be in coin.

“(2) There is hereby exempted from the application of regulation 3 (aa) of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 2 (1) of the Exchange Control Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 1‡) the bringing into New Zealand by travellers of New Zealand money (being notes in denominations of 10s. or £1 or coin of any denomination) not exceeding £5, of which not more than £2 may be in coin.”

3. The following provisions of the principal notice are hereby revoked, namely:

- (a) Paragraph (a) of clause 4:
- (b) Paragraph (b) of clause 8.
