THE EXCHANGE CONTROL EXEMPTION NOTICE 1965, AMENDMENT NO. 4

PURSUANT to the Exchange Control Regulations 1965*, the Minister of Finance hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Exchange Control Exemption Notice 1965, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Exchange Control Exemption Notice 1965† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Sterling area—(1) The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule hereto.
- (2) The Exchange Control Exemption Notice 1965, Amendment No. 1‡, is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This notice excludes Burma from the list of sterling area countries (for the purposes of the Exchange Control Exemption Notice 1965), and includes Barbados, Botswana, Guyana, Lesotho, and the Maldive Islands in that list. In other respects it re-enacts, with minor drafting modifications, the existing list as set out in the Schedule to the 1965 notice and amended by the Exchange Control Exemption Notice 1965, Amendment No. 1.
