THE EDUCATION (SCHOOL COMMITTEES' INCIDENTAL EXPENSES) REGULATIONS 1956, AMENDMENT NO. 2

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (School Committees' Incidental Expenses) Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (School Committees' Incidental Expenses) Regulations 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. (1) Regulation 5 of the principal regulations, as amended by regulation 2 of the Education (School Committees' Incidental Expenses) Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 1, is hereby further amended by revoking subparagraph (xii) of paragraph (a) of subclause (2), and substituting the following subparagraph:

"(xii) The rental of one telephone installed in public schools, in health camp schools, in secondary departments of district high schools where the secondary department is established on a site separate from the primary department, in occupation centres, in speech clinics, and in remedial reading clinics; but in no case the rental of a telephone installed in the living quarters of a teacher which are not a teacher's residence provided by the Board, or the rental of the extension to any telephone:

"Provided that where the school telephone is installed in the teacher's residence instead of in the school or where there is an extension from the telephone installed in the school to the teacher's residence, half the cost of the rental of the school

telephone shall be payable."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations vary the provisions governing the circumstances in which School Committees may resort to the grant for incidental expenses in order to pay the rental on telephones installed in school premises.
