## THE ELECTRICITY CONTROL ORDER 1948, AMENDMENT NO. 10

PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1968 and the Electricity Control Regulations 1949, the General Manager of the New Zealand Electricity Department hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Electricity Control Order 1948, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electricity Control Order 1948 (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
  - (2) This order shall come into force on the 30th day of May 1975.
- 2. Restrictions on public lighting—Clause 13A of the principal order (as inserted by clause 2 of the Electricity Control Order 1948, Amendment No. 9) is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (e) of subclause (1) and paragraph (c) of subclause (2).
