**THE ELECTRICITY CONTROL ORDER 1948,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to the Electricity Control Regulations 1949,\* the General Manager of the State Hydro-electric Department hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Electricity Control Order 1948, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electricity Control Order 1948† (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The principal order is hereby amended by revoking Part VI.

3. Clause 4 of the principal order is hereby consequentially amended by revoking the definitions of the terms "owner" and "radiator element".
