THE ELECTRICITY CONTROL ORDER 1948, AMENDMENT NO. 12

PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1968 and the Electricity Control Regulations 1949* the General Manager of the New Zealand Electricity Department hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Electricity Control Order 1948, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electricity Control Order 1948[†]. (2) This order shall come into force on the 15th day of January 1976.

2. Restrictions on public lighting—The Electricity Control Order 1948, Amendment No. 11, is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from clause 2 the words "the 16th day of January 1976", and substituting the words "the 30th day of January 1976":
- (b) By omitting from clause 3 the words "the 17th day of January 1976", and substituting the words "the 31st day of January 1976".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order extends the period of suspension of Part IVA of the Electricity Control Order 1948 from 16 January 1976 to 30 January 1976. The effect is to remove restrictions on the use of electricity for advertising, floodlighting, decorative lighting, and illuminated signs during that extended period.
