**THE ELECTRICITY CONTROL ORDER 1948,
AMENDMENT NO. 6**

PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1968 and the Electricity Control Regulations 1949*, the General Manager of the New Zealand Electricity Department hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Electricity Control Order 1948, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electricity Control Order 1948† (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Restrictions on public lighting—(1) The principal order (as amended by regulation 2 of the Electricity Control Order 1948, Amendment No. 5) is hereby further amended by revoking Part IVA.

(2) The Electricity Control Order 1948, Amendment No. 5, is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the Electricity Control Order 1948. The effect is to remove restrictions on the use of electricity for advertising, floodlighting, illuminated signs, and the lighting of shop windows.
