EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.]

This order declares the Auckland City Council to be an authorized person for the purposes of the Evidence Act 1908. The effect of the order is that section 5 of the Evidence Amendment Act 1952 will apply to the Council, so that photographic copies of its records will be admissible in evidence.
