EXPLANATORY NOTE

This order declares certain companies to be authorised persons for the purposes of the Evidence Act 1908. The effect of the order is that section 5 of the Evidence Amendment Act 1952 will apply to the companies so that photographic copies of their records will be admissible in evidence.
