- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Evidence (Photographic Copies) Order 1973.
- 2. Authorised persons—The companies, society, and authority specified in the Schedule to this order are hereby declared to be authorised persons for the purposes of the Evidence Act 1908.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order declares Databank Systems Limited, J. Wattie Canneries Limited, the Auckland Co-operative Terminating Building Society, and the Rotorua Area Electricity Authority to be authorised persons for the purposes of the Evidence Act 1908. The effect of the order is that section 5 of the Evidence Amendment Act 1952 will apply to them so that photographic copies of their records will be admissible in evidence.
