Pursuant to the Evidence Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 2. The Council and Board specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be authorised persons for the purposes of the Evidence Act 1908.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order declares the Hutt County Council and the Waikato Hospital Board to be authorised persons for the purposes of the Evidence Act 1908. The effect of the order is that section 5 of the Evidence Amendment Act 1952 will apply to the Council and the Board, so that photographic copies of their records will be admissible in evidence.
