ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 22nd day of July 1985

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Reserve Bank of New Zealand Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Exchange Control Regulations 1985, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Exchange Control Regulations 1985\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 30th day of July 1985.

**2. First Schedule amended**—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the name “Hill Samuel New Zealand Limited”, and substituting the name “FAS Macquarie Limited”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 30 July 1985, amend the list of authorised foreign exchange dealers that is set out in the First Schedule to the Exchange Control Regulations 1985. The amendment recognises that the name of Hill Samuel New Zealand Limited is to be changed on that date to FAS Macquarie Limited.
