HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Reserve Bank of New Zealand Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Exchange Control Regulations 1985, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Exchange Control Regulations 1985* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. First Schedule amended—The First Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by the Exchange Control Regulations 1985, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended by inserting before the name
