ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 15th day of January 1973

Pursuant to section 135 of the Customs Act 1966, as amended by section 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, it being the opinion of the Minister of Customs that the manufacture of cigars and snuff containing less than 75 percent of tobacco grown in New Zealand is unduly detrimental to the public revenues, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Excise Duty (Cigars and Snuff) Order 1973.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Excise duty on certain cigars and snuff—There is hereby prescribed an excise duty at the rate of \$3.18 per pound on all cigars and snuff containing less than 75 percent of tobacco grown in New Zealand and made in any calendar year by or on behalf of Rothmans Tobacco Company Limited, of Napier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order prescribes a rate of excise duty of \$3.18 per pound on all cigars and snuff containing less than 75 percent of tobacco grown in New Zealand and manufactured by or on behalf of Rothmans Tobacco Company Limited, of Napier.
