ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 29th day of April 1974

Present:

THE HON. H. WATT PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 135 of the Customs Act 1966, as amended by section 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

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ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Excise Duty (Cigars and Snuff) Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1974.

2. Excise duty on certain cigars and snuff—The rate of excise duty on all cigars and snuff containing less than 75 percent of tobacco grown in New Zealand made by or on behalf of G. Pezaro and Son Limited, of Auckland, and Rothmans Tobacco Company Limited, of Napier, and entered for home consumption on and after the above date shall be \$7.01 per kilogram.

3. Consequential revocations—The Excise Duty (Cigars and Snuff) Order 1970* and the Excise Duty (Cigars and Snuff) Order 1973† are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides, in respect of all cigars and snuff containing less than 75 percent of tobacco grown in New Zealand, for the calculation of excise duty on the metric equivalent of the existing imperial unit.
