



**THE ENGINE DRIVERS' EXAMINATION REGULATIONS
1952, AMENDMENT NO. 11**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 14th day of April 1980

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 58 of the Boilers, Lifts, and Cranes Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Engine Drivers' Examination Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 11, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Engine Drivers' Examination Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1980.

2. Fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 14 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Engine Drivers' Examination Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 10), and substituting the following regulation:

“14. (1) Each application for examination shall be accompanied by the following fee appropriate to the certificate of competency:

“(2) Each application for replacement of any certificate of competency that has been lost or destroyed shall be accompanied by a fee of \$8.”

3. Revocation—The Engine Drivers' Examination Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 10 are hereby revoked.
