ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of July 1976

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 63 of the Distillation Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Excise Duty (Whisky) Order 1976. (2) This order shall come into force on the 30th day of July 1976.

2. Excise duty on whisky—The rate of excise duty on spirit made or distilled in New Zealand of the class or kind specified in the Schedule to this order and entered for home consumption on or after the above date shall be \$3.386 per proof litre.

3. Consequential revocation—The Excise Duty (Whisky) Order 1974* is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

CLASS OR KIND OF SPIRIT

SPIRITS and spirituous mixtures, the strength of which can be ascertained by Sikes's hydrometer or other similar instrument, viz: Whisky.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order provides, in respect of whisky manufactured in New Zealand, a new rate of excise duty of \$3.386 per proof litre.
