ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 30th day of June 1980

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 63 of the Distillation Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Excise Duty (Spirits) Order 1980.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 4th day of July 1980.

2. Excise duty on certain spirits—The rate of excise duty on spirits made or distilled in New Zealand of the classes or kinds specified in the Schedule hereto and entered for home consumption on or after the date of the commencement of this order shall be as prescribed in the said Schedule.

3. Consequential revocation—The Excise Duty (Spirits) Order 1979* is hereby consequentially revoked.

SCHEDULE

CLASSES OR KINDS OF SPIRITS

	Rate per proof litre
Spiritous beverages, viz:	
(a) Whisky	\$4.35
(b) Gin, Geneva, Schnapps, and Vodka	\$4.50
(c) Other kinds containing more than 40 percent of proof spirit as may be approved by the Minister	\$4.50

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides for new excise duty rates with effect from 4 July 1980 in respect of New Zealand manufactured whisky, gin, geneva, schnapps, vodka, and other spirituous products containing more than 40 percent of proof spirit, approved by the Minister. The new excise duty rates are as follows:

	Per proof litre
Whisky	\$4.35
Gin, Geneva, Schnapps, and Vodka	\$4.50
Other spirituous products as may be approved by the Minister	\$4.50
