ORDER IN COUNCIL

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 18 and 22 of the Territorial Sea and Exclusive Economic Zone Act 1977, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title, commencement, and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Exclusive Economic Zone (Licence Fees and Royalties) Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Exclusive Economic Zone (Licence Fees and Royalties) Regulations 1988* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, and shall apply in respect of every licence granted or renewed on or after that 28th day.

Licence fees and royalties—The principal regulations are hereby amended by omitting from the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Exclusive Economic Zone (Licence Fees and Royalties) Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 2) the items relating to ling, oreo dories, and squid, and substituting, respectively, the following items:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette, amend the Exclusive Economic Zone (Licence Fees and Royalties) Regulations 1988 by—

- (a) Increasing the licence fees in respect of ling taken in the Sub-Antarctic area from \$70 to \$110 per tonne:
- (b) Increasing the fees in respect of oreo dories taken in the Auckland, Central, Challenger, and Southland areas from \$40 to \$70 per tonne:
- (c) Increasing the fees in respect of squid taken in the Southland area from \$60 to \$115 per tonne.
