# ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 10th day of November 1980

## Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 22 of the Territorial Sea and Exclusive Economic Zone Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

# REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Exclusive Economic Zone (Foreign Fishing Craft) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Exclusive Economic Zone (Foreign Fishing Craft) Regulations 1978\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1981.

2. Restrictions on squid jigging—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 31, the following regulation:

"31A. No licensed craft shall be used in fishing for squid by the method known as squid jigging in any area specified in the Third Schedule to these regulations."

(2) The principal regulations are hereby further amended by addin the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

# NEW THIRD SCHEDULE ADDED TO PRINCIPAL REGULATIONS "THIRD SCHEDULE

## Reg. 31A

## Areas Closed to Squid Jigging by Foreign Fishing Craft

The area enclosed by a line commencing at a point  $40^{\circ}$  19.4' S and 173° 00.5' E; and then proceeding directly through a south-easterly direction to a point 40° 27.8' S and 174° 00' E; and then proceeding through a south-westerly direction along the outer limits of the territorial sea of New Zealand to the first-mentioned point."

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations close Tasman Bay to foreign fishing craft engaged in jigging for squid.
