ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 11th day of September 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Territorial Sea and Exclusive Economic Zone Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Exclusive Economic Zone (Licence Fees for Foreign Fishing Craft) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Exclusive Economic Zone (Licence Fees for Foreign Fishing Craft) Regulations 1978*.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fees for licences to fish for squid by trawling—(1) The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from item 1 the words “or trawling”.

(2) The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by inserting, after item 1, the following item:

“1A. Licence to fish for squid by trawling \$55 per tonne of fish that the craft is permitted by the conditions of its licence to take.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of this amendment is to reduce from \$80 per tonne to \$55 per tonne (as permitted by the licence) the rate of the fee for a licence to take squid by trawling in the exclusive economic zone.
