HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 22 of the Territorial Sea and Exclusive Economic Zone Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title, commencement, and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Exclusive Economic Zone (Licence Fees for Foreign Fishing Craft) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Exclusive Economic Zone (Licence Fees for Foreign Fishing Craft) Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, and shall apply in respect of every licence granted under section 15 of the Act to have effect on or after the 1st day of December 1980.

2. Schedule—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Exclusive Economic Zone (Licence Fees for Foreign Fishing Craft) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 4), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

3. Revocation—Regulation 3 of, and the Schedule to, the Exclusive Economic Zone (Licence Fees for Foreign Fishing Craft) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 4 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for an increase in the fees payable by foreign fishing craft for licences to fish in the exclusive economic zone-

(a) For southern bluefin tuna by long-lining, from \$9,000 to \$27,000 a year: (b) For skipjack tuna by purse-seining, from \$40.75 to \$60 per tonne.
