THE EMERGENCY FORCE ACTIVE SERVICE ORDER 1950

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to regulation 8A of the Defence Emergency Regulations 1941,* I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare as follows :—

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Emergency Force Active Service Order 1950.

2. The emergency military force raised under Part I of the Emergency Forces Act, 1950, or any portion of that force shall be on active service from the issue of a military order posting it for active service until the issue of a military order that it has ceased to be on active service.

3. Every officer or soldier of the said emergency force shall be on active service when a military order has been issued posting him for active service or when the portion of the emergency force of which he forms part or to which he is attached is on active service, and in either case shall continue to be on active service until the issue of a military order that he or the portion of the emergency force of which he forms part or to which he is attached has ceased to be on active service.
