**THE EMERGENCY FORCE (VISITING FORCES) ORDER 1951**

PURSUANT to subsection (5) of section 6 of the Visiting Forces Act, 1939, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, Governor-General of New Zealand, do hereby make the following order.

---

**ORDER**

1. This order may be cited as the Emergency Force (Visiting Forces) Order 1951.

2. It is hereby declared that the emergency force raised under Part I of the Emergency Forces Act, 1950, is serving together and acting in combination with every part of the military forces, other than the military forces of His Majesty raised in New Zealand, to which section 6 of the Visiting Forces Act, 1939, applies, and with which the said emergency force is serving from time to time in support of United Nations action in Korea.
