# ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of August 1966

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Forces Rehabilitation Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Emergency Forces Rehabilitation Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Emergency Forces Rehabilitation Regulations 1953\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after subclause (1A) (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Emergency Forces Rehabilitation Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 3), the following subclause:

"(1B) Notwithstanding anything in subclause (1) of this regulation, in these regulations the term 'serviceman' also includes any person who has served in the South-East Asia service area or in waters adjacent thereto, as a member of the New Zealand Armed Forces at any time on or after the 1st day of January 1964. If any question arises as to whether any place forms part of the South-East Asia service area, it shall be determined by the Minister, whose decision shall be final."

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations extend the definition of the term "serviceman" for the purposes of the principal regulations to include members of the New Zealand Armed Forces who have served in South-East Asia or in waters adjacent thereto on or after 1 January 1964.
