HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education (Private Foreign Students) Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Private Foreign Students) Regulations 1984\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Additions to list of South Pacific countries**—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the terms “The Marshalls”, “New Caledonia”, and “Palau”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations add the Marshalls, New Caledonia, and Palau, to the list of South Pacific countries specified for the purposes of section 9A (3) (a) of the Education Act 1964. Private students from countries so specified who study at tertiary institutions in New Zealand are exempt from the payment of the fees required to be paid by other private foreign students.
