THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (Post-primary Instruction) Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Post-primary Instruction) Regulations 1945* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from subclause (2) the words “the commencement of the third term”, and substituting the words “the termination of the second term”; and
- (b) By omitting from the proviso to subclause (3) the words “than the 22nd day of October in any year”, and substituting the words “in any year than the Friday immediately following the date of the commencement of the third term in public post-primary schools as that date is fixed by regulations for the time being in force”.
