PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title**—These regulations may be cited as the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1968\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

**2. Award of Lower Sixth Form Certificate**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 16, and substituting the following heading and regulation:

*“Lower Sixth Form Certificate*

“16. The Lower Sixth Form Certificate shall be awarded to every pupil who—

- “(a) Has been accepted for entry to the Lower Sixth Form in any school, department, or class to which Part II of these regulations applies; and
- “(b) Has thereafter satisfactorily completed an advanced course of instruction of one year, including therein at least four units in each of four subjects approved by the Director-General, which subjects shall include at least two, of which one shall be English, prescribed for the University Entrance Examination.”

**3. Award of Higher School Certificate**—Regulation 18 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the words “awarded a School Certificate”, and substituting the words “accepted for entry to the Lower Sixth Form in any school, department, or class to which Part II of these regulations applies”.

**4. Award of Higher School Certificate in Fine Arts**—Regulation 18A of the principal regulations, as inserted by regulation 3 of the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 1, is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the words “awarded a School Certificate”, and substituting the words “accepted for entry to the Lower Sixth Form in any school, department, or class to which Part II of these regulations applies”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations provide for the award of a Lower Sixth Form Certificate which will take the place of the endorsed School Certificate. They also provide for minor changes in the conditions for the award of the Higher School Certificate and the Higher School Certificate in Fine Arts.
