HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Interpretation—(1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by—

(a) Inserting in the definition of the term “Group B subject”, after the word “German”, the words “German audio-lingual”;

(b) Adding to the definition of the term “Group B subject” the words “technical drawing”.

(2) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by adding to the definition of the term “Group C subject” the word “science”.

(3) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from the definition of the term “Group C subject” the words “general science”.

(4) Subclause (3) of this regulation shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1971.
