THE EDUCATION (SECONDARY INSTRUCTION) REGULATIONS 1968, AMENDMENT NO. 5

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Award of Lower Sixth Form Certificate—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 16 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following regulation:

"16. (1) A pupil shall be eligible for the award of the Lower Sixth Form Certificate if-

- "(a) He has been accepted for entry into the Lower Sixth Form in any school, department, or class to which Part II of these regulations applies; and
- "(b) He has thereafter undertaken an advanced course of instruction of 1 year, including therein at least 4 units in each of no fewer than 4 subjects, which subjects shall include at least 2, of which 1 shall be English, prescribed for the University Entrance Examination.

"(2) A pupil eligible in accordance with subclause (1) of this regulation for the award of the Lower Sixth Form Certificate, shall be awarded that certificate in respect of each subject of 4 units approved by the Director-General which he has satisfactorily completed as part of his advanced course of instruction of 1 year undertaken in accordance with paragraph (b) of subclause (1) of this regulation."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1968, to enable the Lower Sixth Form Certificate to be awarded in each of the approved subjects comprising the advanced course for the Certificate.
