At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of July 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL. PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Secondary Instruction) Regulations 1975* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1981.
- 2. Payment of late fee deferred in certain circumstances— Notwithstanding subclauses (2) and (4) of regulation 6 of the principal regulations, the Director-General shall accept, without payment of any late fee, every entry for the 1981 School Certificate Examination received by him before the 11th day of August 1981 that would have been acceptable had it so been received on the 1st day of August 1981.
